Subject: 2016 Statewide Indirect Cost Allocation Plan Approval

The Statewide Indirect Cost Allocation Plan for FY2018 (based on actual numbers from FY 2016) has been approved by the United States Department of Health and Human Services – Cost Allocation Services. This approval authorizes state agencies/institutions conducting federally supported programs to include as part of their operating costs the central service agency costs that have been allocated to their agency/institution through this cost plan.

The schedule of interest expense incurred on bonds issued by the Department of State Treasurer and allocated to the universities based upon bond proceed distributions is also attached as supplemental information. Universities conducting federal programs and desiring to charge these programs with interest expense incurred on statewide university construction bonds may wish to use these amounts in your indirect cost agreement.

The approved 2016 Statewide Indirect Costs Allocation Agreement and related fixed costs for the year ended June 30, 2018 is located on the Office of State Controller's website and can be accessed by clicking on this [link](#).

Dear Dr. Combs:

The negotiation agreement approving the central services cost allocation plan for the fiscal year ending (FY) June 30, 2018 is enclosed. This agreement reflects an understanding reached between your organization and a member of my staff concerning the central service costs that may be included as indirect costs in your departments and agencies that have Federal grants and/or contracts.

Please have the agreement signed by an authorized representative of your organization and return within ten business days of receipt. The signed agreement can be sent to me by email, while retaining the copy for your files. Only when the signed agreement is returned, will we then reproduce and distribute the agreement to the appropriate awarding organizations of the Federal government for their use.

During our review of the central services cost allocation plan, the following was disclosed:

1. Our review included the State's public universities' share of the interest costs incurred by the State to service the General Obligation Bonds. It was determined that the total interest expense for the universities combined were \$25,765,878 for the FYE June 30, 2016.
2. We have not completed our review of the State's FYE June 30, 2016 contributions to the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System of North Carolina ("TSERS"). For the 2016 fiscal year, TSERS reported an actuarially determined contribution equal to 8.69 percent of covered payroll. However, during that year, the employers under the system contributed 9.15 percent of covered payroll to the system as established under North Carolina law. 2 CFR 200.431(g)(6)(iii) states, "Amounts funded by the non-Federal entity in excess of the actuarially determined amount for a fiscal year may be used as the non-Federal entity's contribution in future periods." On December 4, 2018, the State provided a letter explaining why the State believes that the full pension contributions made in FYE June 30, 2016 should be allowed. We will complete our review of this issue as soon as possible.

Approval of the State's central service cost allocation plan is contingent upon the State's agreement to refund the Federal shares of any remaining reserves in excess of reasonable working capital reserves, as defined by Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations (2 CFR), Part 200, Appendix V, Paragraph G.2., as of June 30, 2022 for the DIT Service Areas listed above. Please acknowledge your concurrence with this condition by counter-signing this letter on the next page and returning it to me.

SECTION I: ALLOCATED COSTS

SECTION III: CONDITIONS

The amounts approved in Section I and the billings for the services listed in Section II are subject to the following conditions:

A. **LIMITATIONS:** (1) Charges resulting from this Agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. (2) Such charges represent costs incurred by the State/locality which are legal obligations of the State/locality and are allowable under Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200 (2 CFR 200). (3) The same costs that are treated as indirect costs are not claimed as direct costs. (4) Similar types of costs are accorded consistent accounting treatment. (5) The information provided by the State/locality which was used to establish this Agreement is not later found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate.

B. **ACCOUNTING CHANGES:** This Agreement is based on the accounting system purported by the State/locality to be in effect during the Agreement period. Changes to the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from use of this Agreement require prior approval of the authorized representative of the Cognizant Agency. Such changes include, but are not limited to, changes in the charging of a particular type of cost from allocated cost to a billed cost. Failure to obtain approval may result in cost disallowances.

C. **FIXED AMOUNTS:** If fixed amounts are approved in Section I of this Agreement, they are based on an estimate of the costs for the period covered by the Agreement. When the actual costs for this period are determined, adjustments will be made to the amounts of a future year to compensate for the difference between the costs used to establish the fixed amounts and actual costs.

D. **BILLED COSTS:** Charges for the services listed in Section II will be billed in accordance with rates established by the State/locality. These rates will be based on the estimated costs of providing the services. Adjustments for variances between billed costs and the actual allowable costs of providing the services, as defined by 2 CFR 200, will be made in accordance with procedures agreed to between the State/locality and the Cognizant Agency.

E. **USE BY OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES:** This Agreement was executed in accordance with the authority in 2 CFR 200, and should be applied to grants, contracts and other agreements covered by that Circular, subject to any limitations in Paragraph A above. The State/locality may provide copies of the Agreement to other Federal Agencies to give them early notification of the Agreement.
