Subject: 2019 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

On July 16, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:40 a.m., the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer an ethics course by webcast exclusively for State government employees. This course, <u>2019 Professional</u> <u>Ethics and Conduct</u>, will satisfy the State CPA Board's annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 08G.0410 Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE]. To register for this webcast:

- Attendees **must pre-register** for the webcast on the Office of the State Controller website at https://www.osc.nc.gov/training/cpe-events/2019-professional-ethics-and-conduct-webinar-pre-registration. The pre-registration deadline is May 29, 2019. (Payment **should not** be made at this time).
- On June 5, 2019, all pre-registered attendees will receive notification by email (from NCACPA) to register
 for this webcast. NCACPA will provide registration instructions and payment options in their email.
 NCACPA accepts payment by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and American Express) and by check
 (payable to NCACPA). The registration fee is \$52 per attendee. Only those individuals who complete the
 NCACPA registration and payment process will be permitted to participate in this activity.

Melissa Critcher, CPA, will be the course instructor. Ms. Critcher's background includes experience with employee benefit plans as well as various clients in the manufacturing and distribution industries and professional service organizations.
