RE: 2013 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

On July 16, 2013 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:10 p.m., the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer an ethics course by webcast exclusively for State government employees. This course, 2013 Professional Ethics and Conduct, will satisfy the State CPA Board's annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 08G.0410 *Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE*]. To register for this webcast:

- Attendees **must pre-register** by clicking on the "Training" link at the top of the OSC web page (<http://www.osc.nc.gov>). The pre-registration deadline is June 4, 2013 (Payment **should not** be made at this time).
- On June 11, all pre-registered attendees will receive notification by email (from NCACPA) to register for this webcast. NCACPA will provide registration instructions and payment options in their email. NCACPA accepts payment by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and American Express) and by check (payable to NCACPA). The registration fee is **\$50 per attendee** (payable to NCACPA). Only those individuals who complete the NCACPA registration and payment process will be permitted to participate in this activity.

Jonathan Kraftchick, the Senior Manager of Training and Development in the Raleigh Office of Cherry Bekaert LLP will be the course instructor. Mr. Kraftchick is responsible for overseeing much of the firm's audit training, and course development. He conducts audit and consulting engagements for a wide variety of companies and industries throughout the Southeast and prepares and presents courses for his firm and many external audiences. Mr. Kraftchick served as an adjunct professor at Elon University in its accounting department, and in 2011, received NCACPA's Outstanding Seminar Discussion Leader Award. Mr. Kraftchick holds a BA in economics and a masters in accounting from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

On November 19, 2013 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:10 p.m., the NCACPA will also offer a second ethics course via webcast, exclusively for State government employees. More information about this webcast will be forthcoming in October.
